HELPFUL HINTS FOR COMPLETING A MUSICARES APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: You only need to document **ONE**. 3 years in the music industry should apply to most SCL members. See below.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must be able to document participation in one of the following areas:

 At least 3 years of employment in the music industry and/or
 6 commercially released recordings (singles)
 6 commercially or promotionally released music videos

ARE YOU RECEIVING UNEMPLOYMENT: If you've applied for unemployment, but haven't yet received it, the answer for this field is **NO**.



MEMBERSHIPS FIELD: <u>IMPORTANT</u>: If you're seeking assistance via the relief package being contributed to MusiCares via the PROs, then <u>ONLY list your PRO and Member # here</u>:



CAREER HISTORY FIELDS: Composers should fill these out like this:



BRIEF WORK HISTORY: This is where you can list Film/TV/Video Games credits. You don't have to list everything you've ever done, but we suggest listing 6-10 credits.

DOCUMENTING LOSS OF INCOME: This can be as simple as a screen shot/PDF of an email from someone saying the show/film as canceled/on hiatus, or you could use a redacted page from a contract that proves you had a scoring job in the works. If you have nothing in writing and were told of a lost scoring job by phone, ask them to send you a quick email confirming.

Please upload documentation of loss of income (copy of your contract, flyers or links to event sites listing your involvement in the canceled event, letter/email from employer identifying cancellation, etc)
